Description



How to Use Binoculars

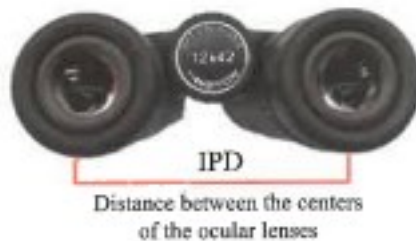
1. Adjust eyecups ..

The eyecups on the binoculars can be twisted up and down, keep them fully extended when you aren't wearing glasses (twist them down when wearing glasses).



2. Adjust the interpupillary distance

The interpupillary distance (IPD) is the distance between the centers of your left and right pupil. Match the IPD of your eyes and your binoculars by rotating the barrels in or out until you see a single image free of shading.



3. Adjust center focus

To focus the left eye: close your right eye, focus your left eye on the object and adjust the center focus wheel until the image is in sharp focus.



4. Adjust diopter

To focus the right eye: close your left eye, look through your right eye and adjust the diopter ring until the image is in sharp focus.



5. Re-adjust center focus

Better to readjust the center focus wheel slightly to achieve the best view when using both eyes.



Note: follow step 3 ~ step 5 to achieve best focusing results.

6. Attach the neck strap and eyepiece cap

Tie up the neck strap as shown in the sample picture. To avoid lost of eyepiece cap, put one end of the strap through both the eyepiece cap bracket.



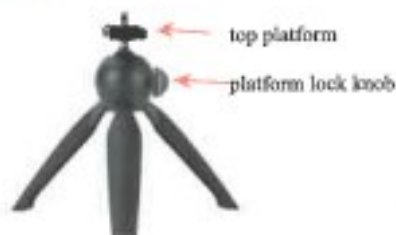
Caution: Binoculars are not intended for looking at the sun, or any other intense light source. Such viewing could damage the retina and cornea of your eyes.

Photographing Accessories



Photographing Set-up Guide

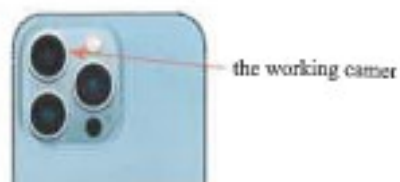
1. Unlock the platform lock knob, adjust the orientation of top platform to upward, then lock the platform lock knob.



2. Connect the tripod adapter to the tripod with the 1st screw hole on the tripod adapter.



3. Identify the working camera of your phone. Open your phone camera, your phone screen will get dark if the working camera are covered with your finger.



4. Pull out the clamp and place your phone inside.

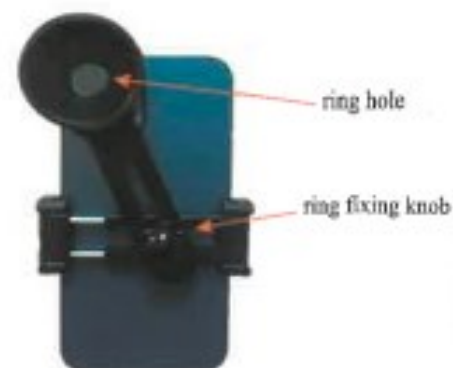


5. Mount your phone on the phone adapter. Set the phone plate close to (not covered) your phone buttons.



6. Align the phone adapter's ring hole to your phone's primary camera, then tight up the ring fixing knob.

Make sure the ring hole is aligned with camera lens, otherwise you can't capture a high-quality image.



7. Hold the phone adapter and press phone screen onto the left eyepiece as shown in the right picture.

Make sure the phone adapter grips the whole eyepiece.



8. Open your phone camera, you may see a circular image in the center of the screen (if the image is not in the center, do step 5 and step 6 again) .



9. Adjust your center focus wheel to get a full and clear edge image.



10. Install your binoculars on the tripod and enjoy photographing. You can zoom in the phone camera on your phone screen to get full screen image.

Maintenance

Maintain the optical brilliance of your binoculars by keeping lens surfaces free of dirt, oil, and dust.

Protect Lenses While Out in the Field

Make use of the provided eyepiece and tethered objective lens covers to protect the lenses when not viewing. If the optics are exposed to moisture, keep the caps off and allow the optics to dry out completely before putting them in the bag for storage.

Keep Lenses Clean

In order to enjoy the best view through your binoculars, take time to regularly clean the exterior lenses.

1. Remove any dust or grit from lenses before wiping. Use a can of pressurized air, soft camel hair brush, or an acrylic optical brush.
2. Clear lenses of smudges, fingerprints, or eyelash oil. Fog the lenses with your own breath, then use a non-abrasive lens cloth to clean the lenses.
3. If the binoculars won't be used for a long time, store them in a dry place.

Note: Use lens cleaning fluid and optical paper to clean lenses. Never use facial tissue, heavy cotton, or flannel clothing on lenses—these materials can scratch the surface of a lens.
